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Supplementary Regulations – The following changes/additions apply:

7.3 Tyre marking and location

All tyres used throughout the duration of the event will be marked at the exit of the Service Park, **except for the Shakedown where they will be marked at the Shakedown start.**

Art. 12.4.1 SSS1

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f. For the first 16 cars in the running order of SSS1, the fitting of extra lights is mandatory. These extra lights must remain switched off during SSS1, unless otherwise authorised by the Clerk of the Course. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 12.12 Regroups TC4A-TC4B, TC11A-TC11B and TC17A-TC17B

Team personnel will not be permitted to enter **at** the regroups between TC4A – TC4B, TC11A – TC11B and TC 17A – TC17B where FIA WRC Art. 42.5.2 (change of windows) will therefore not apply.

Exception:

Team personnel of P1 drivers are allowed at the area preceding TC4A and TC11A for data collection from their rally cars. To travel there, only one car (no van or truck) per competitor is permitted, following the rally route and displaying special stickers provided by the organiser. This car has to be parked in the parking area A as indicated in Rally Guide 2 on page 40.

Itinerary and Art. 60.10 of the 2019 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations

Considering the Itinerary in relation to SS 10, 14 and 16 (extension of the standard 3 minutes between TC and SS start to 8 minutes), the adjustment of tyre pressure is also permitted when the start of SS 10, 14 or 16 is delayed by more than 5 minutes for any competitor.



• **Flame resistant clothing**




The compulsory route in the service park for P2P drivers is the same as for **P2 drivers.**
